


11. Plan napada na Hrvatsku poslije povlačenja JNA iz Slovenije (VII/1991)



11. Plan of the attack to Croatia after the retreat of JNA from Slovenia (July 1991)

1. Directions and targets of the aggressor's attack
2. Line to which the aggressor is retreating after destroying the HV: it is also the western border of the Great Serbia
3. Various sorts of obstruction, which are organized in the entire territory of Croatia and partially in the territory of BH
4. The blockade line between Slovenia and Croatia,
5. Garrisons of the JNA which were blocked by the Croatian forces:

12. Vojno-politička situacija u Hrvatskoj XII/1991 – I/1992.




- 1) Sve garnizone JNA u Hrvatskoj osvojile su hrvatske snage ili su evakuirani.
- 2) Zona srpske oružane pobune smanjena je oslobođenjem sjevernoga dijela zapadne Slavonije, no u trenutku kada treba početi planirani nastavak uspješne ofenzive s crte Pakrac - Požega na Savu politički vrh donosi odluku o prekidu svih aktivnih djelovanja.
- 3) Dva pokušaja debllokade Vukovara nisu uspjela i grad je u rukama agresora.
- 4) Protuudari u bokove neprijateljskog rasporeda u prostoru Bukovice nisu dali znatniji rezultat, ali su granice zona pobune pod kontrolom HV.
- 5) Na crti Ston - Hutovo definitivno je zaustavljen prodor neprijateljskih snaga u dolinu Neretve.
- 6) Poraz JNA na bojištima u Hrvatskoj (teški gubici u borbi za Vukovar i potpun slom u prodoru prema Osijeku i Đakovu te u prodoru na Neretvu) posljedica je djelovanja HV, ali i neuspjeha mobilizacije u Srbiji, gdje su vojni obveznici odbijalići u borbu izvan republike.
- 7) Ukupan odnos snaga potpuno je promijenjen u korist Hrvatske: HV broji oko 250.000 vojnika u 63 brigade i desetima samostalnih bojni, dobro je naoružana i uspostavljen je zadovoljavajući sustav zapovijedanja; u cijelosti je spremna za opću ofenzivu u svrhu uklanjanja oružane pobune i potpunog oslobadanja Hrvatske te,
- 8) u savezništvu s bosansko-hercegovačkim obrambenim snagama, i te države.
- 9) Umjesto opće ofenzive uspostavlja se i u Sarajevu 2. siječnja 1992. potpisuje trajno primirje; rat se prenosi u BiH, a stanje ni rata ni mira potrajat će u Hrvatskoj više od četiri godine.
- 10) Svjestan definitivna poraza, upravljački vrh JNA spasava što može i formira tri srpske vojske: Srpsku vojsku Krajine (za čuvanje teritorijalnih stičevina u Hrvatskoj), Vojsku Republike Srpske (za zauzimanje najvećega djela BiH, 65-70%) i Vojsku Jugoslavije (kao oružanu silu Srbije i Crne Gore). SVK je uništena u proljeće i ljeto 1995. dok druge dvije vojske postoje i danas.

12. The military-political situation in Croatia (December 1991-January 1992)

1. All garrisons of the JNA in Croatia were taken by the Croatian forces or they were evacuated:
2. The zone of the Serbian armed rebellion was reduced through the liberation of the northern part of West Slavonia, however, at the time, when the planned resumption of a successful offensive from the line Pakrac-Pozega towards Sava, the political leadership makes decision on cessation of all combat activities: 3. two attempts of lifting of the blockade in Vukovar failed and the town is now in the aggressor's hands.
4. Counter-strokes into the flanks of the enemy deployment in the area of Bukovica did not provide better results, but the borders of rebellion zones are under the control of the HV:
5. The breakthrough of the enemy forces into the Neretva valley was definitively stopped on the line Ston-Hutovo
6. defeat of the JNA on the battle-fields in Croatia (heavy losses in the fight for Vukovar and a complete collapse in the breakthrough towards Osijek and Djakovo, as well as in the breakthrough towards Neretva) is a consequence of the activities of the HV, as well as the consequence of a failed mobilization in Serbia, where the military conscripts refused to go into fights outside of the republic
7. The total ratio of forces is completely changed in favor of Croatia: the HV has some 250 000 soldiers within 63 brigades and in dozens of independent battalions, it is well-armed and the satisfying system of command is also introduced: it is entirely ready for a general offensive in order to remove the armed rebellion and to completely liberate Croatia and
8. In alliance with the Bosnian-Herzegovinian defence forces, to liberate that state as well.
9. Instead of a general offensive permanent truce is established and signed on 2nd of January 1992 in Sarajevo: the war is being moved to BH, whereas the situation of neither war nor peace in Croatia shall last for another 4 years.
10. Being aware of a definite defeat, the leading management of the JNA has been saving all it can save and establishes three Serbian armies: the Serbian army of the Borderland (in order to preserve the territorial gains in Croatia), the army of Republika Srpska (in order to take the biggest part of the BH 65-70%) and the army of Yugoslavia (as the armed force of Serbia and Monte Negro). the SVK (supreme command staff) was destroyed in spring and summer of 1995, while the other two armies still exist nowadays.

1992-1993, the South of Croatia:

1. 159 soldiers of the HV (4th Guard brigade (4. GBR) defend positions near Citluk (villages of Tepci and Slipci) from 10th of April 1992 till late June 1992: they participated in liberation of Mostar South

2. The units of HV are blocking the breakthrough of the JNA and VRS towards Metkovic and Ploče in 1992

3. The HVO is holding the line towards the VRS, southern from Stolac, TG-2 (there is a quarrel with the HV about who should be in that area/field)


4. The HV is located several kilometers within the BH borders due to the configuration of the field which prevents the army from defending itself on the border - the law of war is completely clear on this issue:


